Observations

- **Product Owner** remains engaged, knowledgeable and empowered.
- Scrum Roles continue to be well understood and respected.
- Team easily **self-organizes** around tasks, and supporting each other.
- **Focus**:: the team has two members full-time. Others are 50% or greater engaged with the project. The lack of dedicated involvement does not appear to impact the project, but does require reduced **focus** due to context switching.
- **Daily Scrum** completed well within the time box, with a brief parking lot discussion.
- **Openness** :: Team is **open** discussing issues, asking for help or gathering and receiving needed information.
- **Respect** :: Team expresses a high degree of respect. Each trusts the other is doing their best. No relational tension detected.
